Nominations may be submitted by the members of the previous two conventions (Calgary and Saratoga Springs) or those who have registered with World Fantasy 2009. All ballots cast will be verified against membership lists from those three conventions.

You may submit up to five nominations in each category, in no particular order. You do not have to nominate items in every category but you must nominate in more than one category. All nominated material must have been published in 2008 or have a 2008 cover date. Only living persons may be nominated. When listing stories or other material that may not be familiar to all the judges, please include pertinent information such as author, editor, publisher, magazine name and date, etc. The items are free betting tips uk not point-rated. The two items receiving the most nominations (except for those ineligible) will be placed on the final ballot.
